

A CHECK LIST OF MARINE AMPHIPODS OF PAKISTAN

Abstract

Seventy species of amphipods belonging to twenty nine families have been recorded from the Pakistan coast as indicated by literature survey and new collections. Among the new collections, 4 species are indetermined and fourteen species are reported from Pakistan for the first time. In the present paper an annotated checklist is given, indicating the original source of the record and any new records for the area..

Introduction

The Amphipoda is an order that includes over 7,000 described species of small shrimp-like crustaceans. The amphipods are ecologically important, and as a component of benthic infaunal communities are a primary food resource for marine invertebrates, fish and bird species of the world.

Few reports on the taxonomy of the amphipods are available from Pakistan. However, there are some studies based on material from Pakistani waters which are included in the present list. Barnard (1937) reports 28 species; Nair (1977& 1992) reported 1 and 2 species respectively; Ahmed (1976) reported 12 species from Karachi coast; Javed (1983; 1987) recorded two species from the northern Arabian sea; Nair and Jayalakshmy (1992) reported 3 species; Nayeem *et al.* (1993) reported 5 species from Pakistani waters. Kazmi (1994; 1995) reported two species. Kazmi and Bano (2003) reported one species. Bano and Kazmi (2004; 2005, 2008a, 2008b, 2010) described a new species and added two species..

The present report adds 18 species to the Pakistan faunal list. 14 are new records, and 4 indetermined species, given here as “sp.”. These may turn out to be new to science and as such will be dealt in separate papers. New records are marked with an asterisk,

The new amphipod collections were obtained both from Sindh and Makran regions of the Pakistan coast from intertidal to subtidal zones. For classification Martin and Davis (2001) is followed, and the list is arranged in alphabetical order by family. The authorities of the taxa are not explained in the references given at the end.
